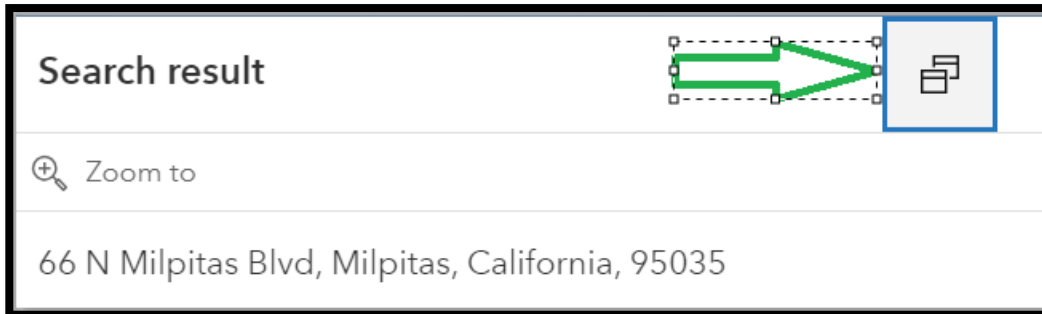

Steps

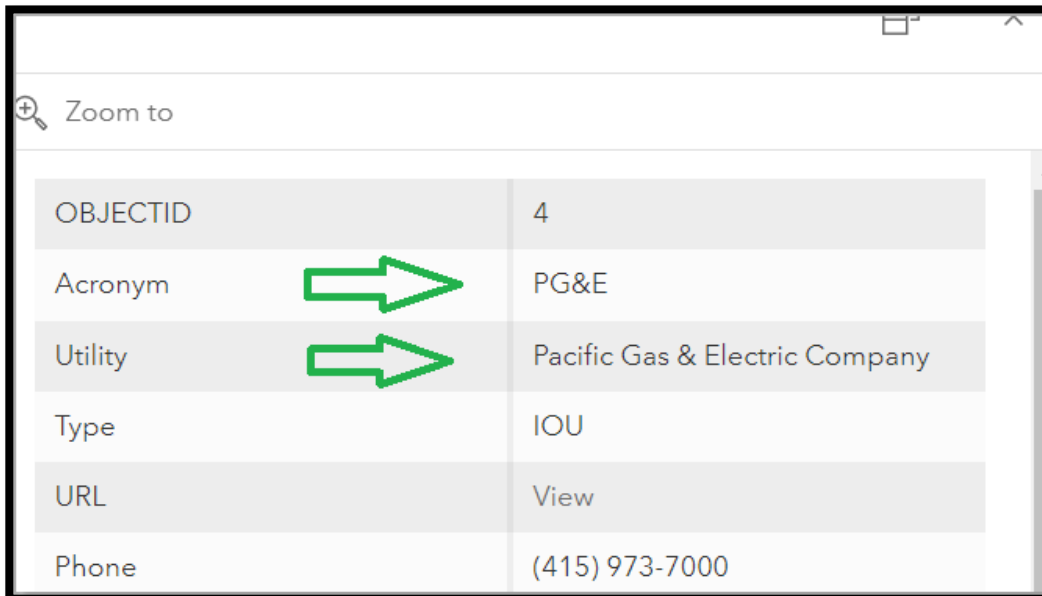
1. Select the link, <https://cecgis-caenergy.opendata.arcgis.com/datasets/electric-load-serving-entities-iou-pou/explore>.
